Essential qualifications

There is no specific professional qualification required as we welcome applications from a wide range of professional backgrounds, however, we do expect applicants to have advanced professional qualifications in a field of work which is relevant to harmful sexual behaviour (HSB) work.

Work experience and skills

Essential experience

The applicant must be able to demonstrate significant experience and their innovative practice in working in the field of children and young people with Harmful Sexual Behaviours (HSB), which may include having written papers and/or articles.

They must also demonstrate that they have significant experience in senior management or strategic leadership of an organisation.

Desirable experience

Experience of working with technology including how they have used their technical ability and skills to create and lead developmental projects.

Experience of working with government departments, expert advisor and lobbying skills

Experience of creative PR and marketing projects

Personal qualities and behavioural traits

To be able to lead and develop people, projects and organisations

Ability to critically analysis information and situations, often in time pressured circumstances
